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A DAYBOAT WITH A MENORQUÍN SOUL

The design is based on the versatility of its outdoor spaces. The sunpads with folding headrests, the foldable tables and the generous shade provided by the hardtop allow the deck to adapt to different moments throughout the day.

The finishes and attention to detail maintain the connection with the identity of SASGA YACHTS, while the outdoor galley and deck layout reflect a practical and contemporary way of enjoying life on board.

The spacious aft platform features a fully integrated swim ladder and is protected by a stainless-steel handrail.

A comfortable space for getting in and out of the water, sitting down after a swim, or safely accompanying younger passengers.



At the stern, two generous sunpads, each nearly two metres long, create a large sunbathing area, divided by a central walkway that allows for easy movement around the deck.

The headrests can be used as support when lying down or rotated to become the backrests of the dinette. In this way, the same space can be easily adapted to suit different moments throughout the day.



The bow offers a second, more sheltered and peaceful relaxation area. It is a particularly pleasant place when the boat is moored, ideal for conversation, reading or simply enjoying a quiet moment away from the activity on the dock.

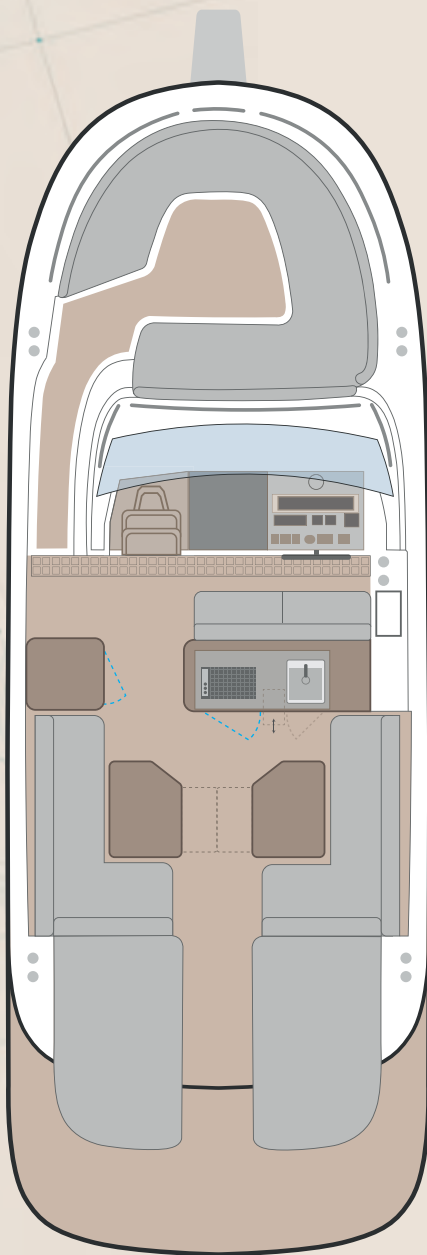

The Menorquín 36 Open is designed around a series of distinct functional areas, each optimised for a specific purpose throughout a day on the water.

Each space is tailored to a particular use, while maintaining smooth circulation and prioritising social life on the main deck.

THE **DECK** IS ARRANGED FROM BOW TO STERN INTO A SERIES OF INTERCONNECTED AREAS, DESIGNED TO FACILITATE ACCESS TO THE WATER, RELAXATION, SOCIALISING AND NAVIGATION.



BOW AREA

The bow offers a second relaxation area, more sheltered and private when the boat is moored. The teak gunwale and SASGA's distinctive "NAS" maintain the connection with the Menorquín identity.

CENTRAL AREA

The **dinette** features **two folding tables** that can be joined together to create a large central table with seating for up to eight people. Alongside it, the outdoor galley incorporates a sink, gas ceramic hob, storage spaces and two refrigerators.

The **helm station** allows for both seated and standing navigation. The seat can be set in two different positions, adapting to a more relaxed cruising style or to those moments when greater visibility is required.

Electronic controls and an ultra-wide display bring all the necessary information together in a single location. The social area and helm station are protected by the hardtop.

AFT AREA

The swim platform features an integrated ladder and a stainless-steel handrail. Moving forward, two generous sunpads create a double sunbathing area, separated by a central walkway that provides easy access to the deck.

DESIGNED TO ENJOY THE DAY. READY TO MAKE IT LAST LONGER.

ALTHOUGH THE MENORQUÍN 36 OPEN IS DESIGNED PRIMARILY FOR ENJOYING LIFE OUTDOORS, ITS INTERIOR PROVIDES THE PRIVACY AND COMFORT NEEDED TO REST, SPEND A NIGHT ON BOARD OR EXTEND A GETAWAY.

THE CONCEPT IS MORE OPEN AND INFORMAL, YET THE WOODWORK, UPHOLSTERY, FINISHES AND HULL CONSTRUCTION MAINTAIN THE HIGH STANDARD OF QUALITY ASSOCIATED WITH SASGA YACHTS.

MAIN LIVING AREA

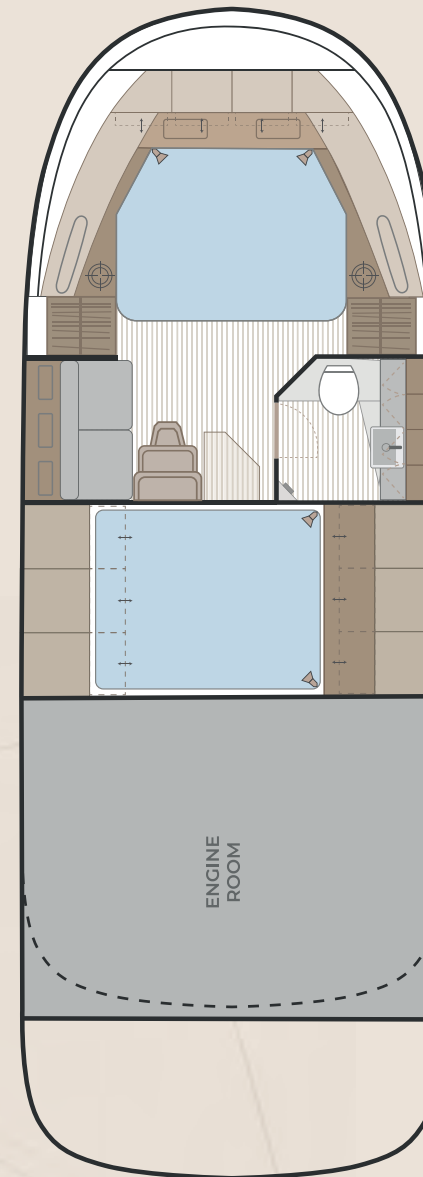
A sliding door provides access to the interior cabin, featuring a 130 cm sofa and fixed berths.

SECOND RELAXATION AREA

The boat also features a second sleeping area with a double bed, providing additional accommodation options on board.
